Planning in relation to the entry road, new gates and entrance and the control tower is currently underway. We hope to provide further updates in our next newsletter. We have currently raised \$117,000 and are hoping to raise \$600,000 to complete the works

Undertake remedial site drainage and surface crack repairs Estimated value of works is \$35,000 - \$50,000	Early 2014
Undertake base preparation and sealing of entrance road Estimated value of works is \$40,000 - \$50,000	Early 2014
Refurbishment and upgrade of the control tower building Estimated value of works is \$60,000 - \$75,000 (subject to the level of in-kind support we are able to obtain)	Christmas Break 2014
Track resurface works Estimated value is \$400,000 - \$450,000	Prior to Winter 2017
